









How to use a sightseeing taxi

Spring Ryuozan Park

What is a sightseeing taxi?

Sightseeing taxi takes customers to the tourist attractions of their choice. The most attractive feature is that customers can freely select sightseeing routes and take a taxi to tourist sites that are not accessible by bus or train without having to transfer.

An advance reservation is required to use a sightseeing

Book a reservation

Please book a reservation by calling a taxi company in the area by the previous day of your preferred day (by 5 p.m.)



Pick-up

A taxi is waiting at the location specified at the time of booking.



Taxi and Sightseeing

Once you get on the taxi, the driver will confirm the sightseeing plan, restaurant, and the place for dropping off. Sightseeing guide is not offered.



Drop-off

The taxi will take you to the place that the driver confirmed with you at the time of the pickup.

Notes for using a sightseeing taxi

- 1) Taxis are standard-sized and jumbo vehicles. Regarding jumbo vehicles, please separately consult with each taxi company.
- 2) The sightseeing plans shown here are sample plans. Please feel free to ask about the sightseeing plans not shown in this brochure.
- 3) The time shown is only an estimate. Some slight delays may occur depending on traffic conditions.
- 4) Prices are fixed for each 30 minutes.
- 5) Prices do not include expressway tolls, entrance fees, admission fees, etc. Other fees are paid by the customers separately.
