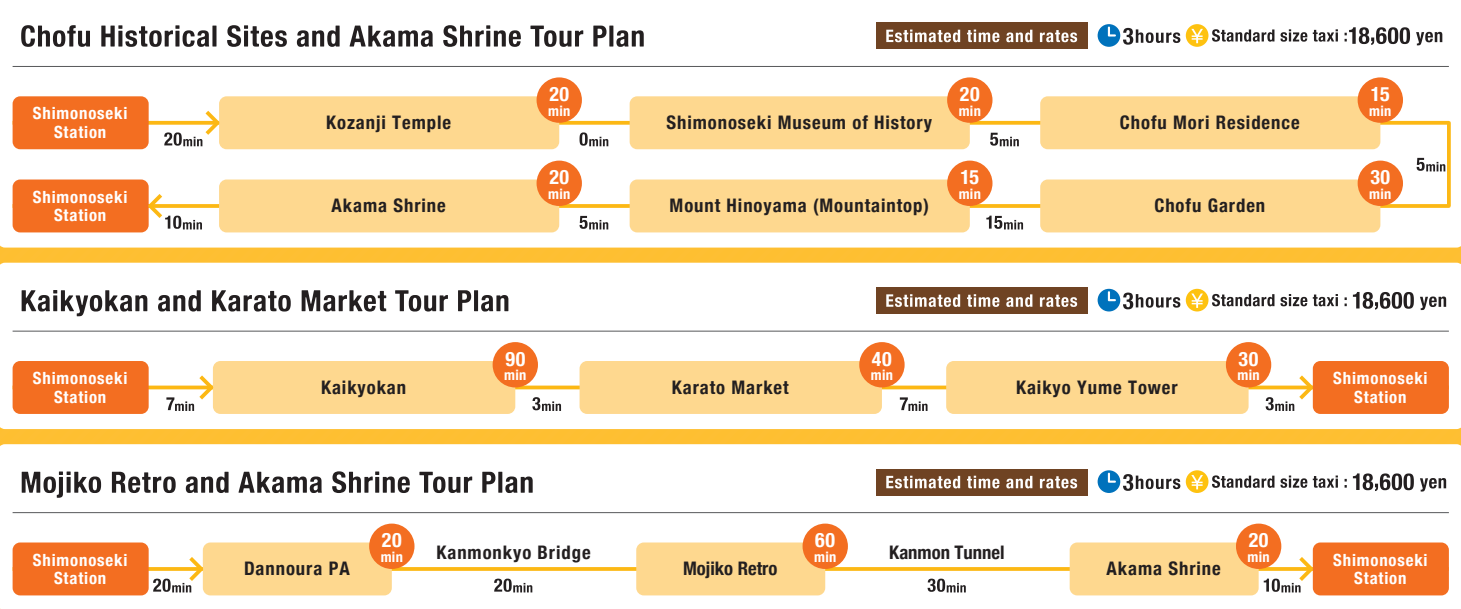
Tourist Attraction Map

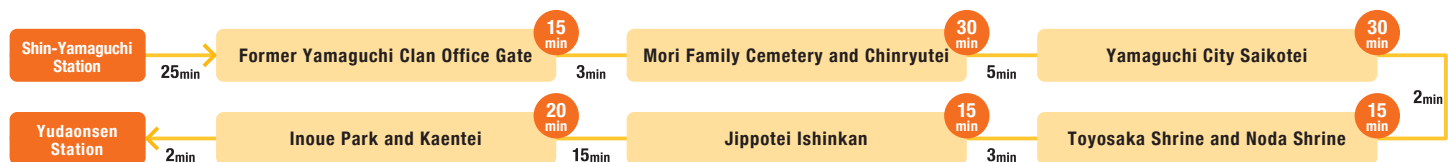

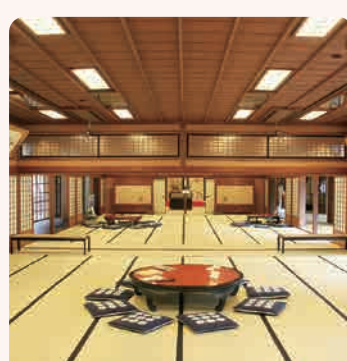

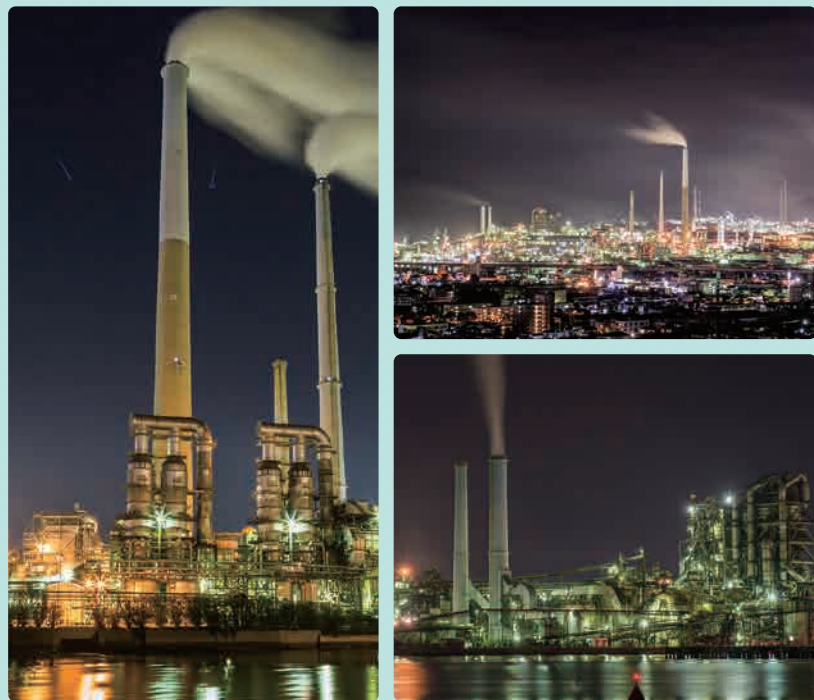

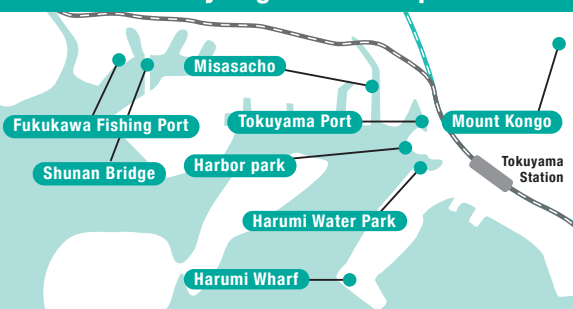
The lights from the petrochemical complex in the dark create fantastic scenes. You will also enjoy dynamic night views of chemical plants and massive chimneys.

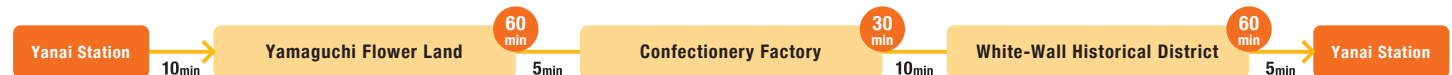

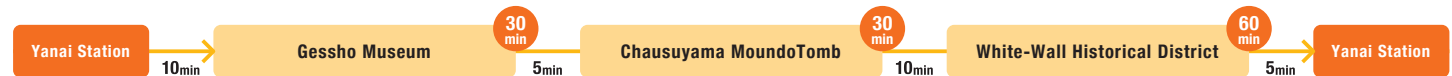

Kikkawa Archives Museum A national treasure, Kitsunegasaki no Tachi, and other fine arts and crafts are displayed.



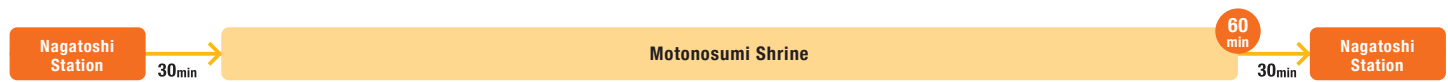

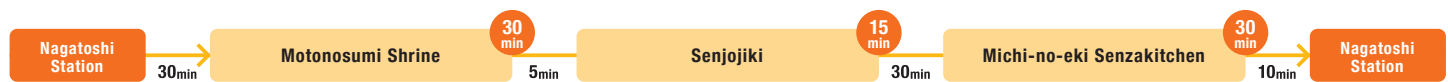

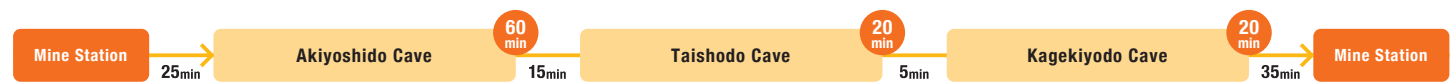

Spring



Ryuoizan Park

Sanyo-Onoda

The views of 10,000 cherry trees and the Seto Inland Sea seen from the observatory are magnificent. **20 minutes from Onoda Station by taxi.**



Ichinosaka River Yamaguchi

Six-hundred-meter cherry blossom tree-lined streets stretch on both banks of the Saka River, which was remodeled to resemble the Kamo River in Kyoto. **5 minutes from Yudaonsen Station by taxi.**

Summer



Tsunoshima Bridge

Shimonoseki

The harmony of the cobalt blue ocean and the Tsunoshima Bridge is breathtaking. **15 to 25 minutes from the nearest station by taxi./Sightseeing taxi is also recommended.**



Yamaguchi Tanabata Lantern Festival Yamaguchi

One of the three major fire festivals in Japan. The fire tunnel with some tens of thousands of red lanterns creates a fantastic atmosphere. **5 minutes from Yudaonsen Station by taxi.**

Fall



Taineiji Temple Nagato

You can see beautiful fall foliage blazing in red and yellow around the temple. **15 minutes from Nagatoshi Station by taxi.**



Chomonkyo Yamaguchi

This national site of scenic beauty offers the sights of colorful fall foliage along the Chomon Gorge. **20 minutes from Ryugubuchi to Chomonkyo Station by taxi.**

Winter



Kanmuriyama Park Hikari

Nearly 2,000 plum trees in 100 varieties bloom on the hill overlooking the Seto Inland Sea. **10 minutes from Hikari Station by taxi.**



Kasayama Camellia Grove Hagi

You will see the views of 25,000 colorful Camellia japonica trees blooming in profusion. **15 minutes from Higashi-Hagi Station by taxi.**

How to use a sightseeing taxi

What is a sightseeing taxi?

Sightseeing taxi takes customers to the tourist attractions of their choice. The most attractive feature is that customers can freely select sightseeing routes and take a taxi to tourist sites that are not accessible by bus or train without having to transfer.

An advance reservation is required to use a sightseeing taxi.

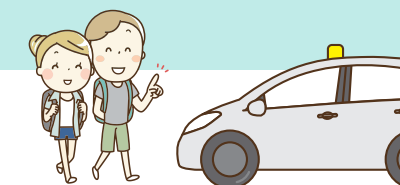
1 Book a reservation

Please book a reservation by calling a taxi company in the area by the previous day of your preferred day (by 5 p.m.)



2 Pick-up

A taxi is waiting at the location specified at the time of booking.



3 Taxi and Sightseeing

Once you get on the taxi, the driver will confirm the sightseeing plan, restaurant, and the place for dropping off. Sightseeing guide is not offered.



4 Drop-off

The taxi will take you to the place that the driver confirmed with you at the time of the pickup.

Notes for using a sightseeing taxi

- 1) Taxis are standard-sized and jumbo vehicles. Regarding jumbo vehicles, please separately consult with each taxi company.
- 2) The sightseeing plans shown here are sample plans. Please feel free to ask about the sightseeing plans not shown in this brochure.
- 3) The time shown is only an estimate. Some slight delays may occur depending on traffic conditions.
- 4) Prices are fixed for each 30 minutes.
- 5) Prices do not include expressway tolls, entrance fees, admission fees, etc. Other fees are paid by the customers separately.
